

Yard Sign Restrictions

Each community has different regulations pertaining to displaying campaign signs. Please follow the rules.

Be sure to check with your municipal clerk for the exact regulations on size and placement of campaign signs.

In general concerning placement of signs – Signs cannot be placed on public property or in the right of way areas near your property.

Belgium:

From first day of election periods as defined in Wis statute (1st day of circulation of nomination papers) to 2 days after the elections.

Cedarburg:

"Campaign season" up to 7 days after the election.

Fredonia:

Municipal code does not specify a time restriction.

Grafton:

45 days prior to the election to 7 days after the election.

Port Washington:

1st day of election period (1st day of circulation of nomination papers) to 5 days after the election.

Saukville:

Municipal code does not specify a time restriction.

Thiensville:

1st day of election period (1st day of circulation of nomination papers) to 24 hour after the election.
